Every day, people in our communities struggle with issues that may seem impossible to solve. Our mission is to motivate and mobilize resources to meet the highest priority needs in Northeast Georgia. We've been doing this since 1954 and will continue to help individuals and families in need across our 12-county region for years to come.

United Way of Northeast Georgia serves Banks, Barrow, Clarke, Elbert, Franklin, Greene, Hart, Jackson, Madison, Morgan, Oconee, and Oglethorpe counties. We are not fundraisers, but are partners supporting our community members and area nonprofits.

United Way of Northeast Georgia uses a Community Impact model, strategically granting funds to programs of area nonprofits. We invest in impact, tracking results of our local nonprofits' programs. We focus on three pillars:

- Basic Needs: Providing resources from hygiene items to food to stable housing option
- Early Childhood Success: Supporting programs from prenatal care to child literacy programs to third-grade proficiency prep

- Workforce Development: Offering opportunities from vocational training to work-study to job retention programs

United Way of Northeast Georgia also provides:

- Assistance to area individuals and families through 211, a health and human services information and referral line available to everyone
- Educational opportunities for nonprofit and community leaders through the Nonprofit Training Series
- Children from birth to age five in Clarke and Oconee counties access to Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program providing age-appropriate books mailed to their homes once a month

United Way of Northeast Georgia works with community leaders, local nonprofits, volunteers, governments, business community members, faith-based entities and more to ensure resources are available to all of our neighbors.
